The agriculture and natural resources industry in Lake, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties provides approximately 55,465 jobs.

These jobs are created from both traditional and non-traditional agriculture, including commercial and residential landscaping services, golf courses, forestry, wood and paper product manufacturing, fruit and vegetable farming and processing, livestock and dairy farming, animal products manufacturing, and mining.
